Objectives: Students will be able to identify parts, layout, measure, cut, nail, and square a wall given a basic blueprint.

Activities:

- 1) Discuss handout of wall components. (H.W.)
- 2) Discuss Layout procedures. (16" on center)
- 3) Discussion and demonstration of hand tools. (hand square/speed square)
- 4) Discussion and demonstration of power tools (circular saw/chop saw)
- 5) Discussion and demonstration of proper nailing procedures. (H.W.)
- 6) Discussion and demonstration of squaring procedures.
